AN ACT PLACING A MORATORIUM UPON THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE LAW CONTROLLING THE DISPOSAL OF SEWAGE FROM WATERCRAFT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Clause (8) of section 27 of chapter 21 of the
2 General Laws, as amended by section 1 of chapter 693 of the
3 acts of 1970, is hereby further amended by striking out the
4 first sentence and inserting in place thereof the following sen-
5 tence: —

6 Adopt, amend, or repeal after hearing from time to time,
7 with the approval of the water resources commission, rules and
8 regulations which it deems necessary for the proper administra-
9 tion of the laws relative to water pollution control and to the
10 protection of the quality and value of water resources, includ-
11 ing regulations to control or prevent discharge of sewage, gar-
12 bage or other waste material from watercraft or any type,
13 including houseboats: provided, however, that there will be a
14 moratorium on all such regulations, which would require instal-
15 lation of equipment on such watercraft.

1 SECTION 2. Section 3 of chapter 693 of the acts of 1970 is
2 hereby stricken and the following new section is hereby
3 inserted: —

4 *Section 3.* Section two of the act shall take effect on May
5 the fifteenth, nineteen hundred and seventy four.
