

HOUSE No. 2560

By Mr. Joyce of Woburn, petition of James E. Begley and Daniel L. AN ACT PROVIDING THAT THE LAW PROVIDING COST-OF-LIVING INCREASES IN PENSIONS, RETIREMENT ALLOWANCES AND ANNUITIES PAYABLE TO CERTAIN RETIRED EMPLOYEES OF THE COMMONWEALTH AND ITS POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS SHALL APPLY TO JUDGES AND THEIR WIDOWS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The provisions of chapter six hundred and
2 sixty-one of the acts of nineteen hundred and sixty-six, as
3 amended by chapter four hundred and eight of the acts of
4 nineteen hundred and sixty-seven, shall apply to pensions
5 payable to judges or the widows of judges under any general or
6 special law.

1 SECTION 2. Section 102 of chapter 32 of the General Laws,
2 as most recently amended by section 2 of chapter 408 of the acts
3 of 1967, is hereby further amended by adding the following
4 paragraph: —

5 As used in this section the word "employee" shall include
6 members of the judiciary.

1 SECTION 3. The provisions of this act shall take effect as of
2 the effective date of chapter six hundred and sixty-one of the
3 acts of nineteen hundred and sixty-six.
