AN ACT PROHIBITING THE OPENING OF ART GALLERIES ON SUNDAYS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 6 of chapter 136 of the General Laws, as most
- 2 recently amended by chapter 309 of the acts of 1970, is

AN ACT TO AMEND THE ACT APPROVED AUGUST ONE, NINETEEN  
NINETEEN

BE IT ENACTED BY THE SENATE AND HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF  
THE COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS, AND BY THE JOINT COMMISSIONERS OF  
THE REVENUE, AS FOLLOWS:

1. Section 6 of chapter 150 of the General Laws, as now  
in force, amended by chapter 107 of the Acts of 1919, is  
further amended by adding thereto the following:
