AN ACT DIRECTING THE MASSACHUSETTS PORT AUTHORITY TO REIMBURSE THE CITY OF BOSTON FOR A PROPORTIONATE SHARE OF THE CITY'S ANNUAL MASSACHUSETTS BAY TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY ASSESSMENTS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the  
2 contrary, including specifically section 17 of chapter 465 of the  
3 acts of 1956, as most recently amended by chapter 719 of the  
4 acts of 1967, the Massachusetts Port Authority is hereby  
5 authorized and directed to reimburse the city of Boston for a  
6 proportionate share of the city of Boston's annual assessments  
7 for the net cost of service provided by the Massachusetts Bay  
8 Transportation Authority in any year in which such assessment  
9 or assessments shall be made upon the city of Boston pursuant  
10 to sections 8, 9, 10 and 11 of chapter 161A of the General  
11 Laws, or pursuant to any acts mandatory thereto.

1 SECTION 2. Upon payment by the city of Boston of the  
2 assessment or assessments for the net cost of service provided  
3 by the Massachusetts Bay Transportation Authority, the city of  
4 Boston shall request payment by the Massachusetts Port  
5 Authority, and the Massachusetts Port Authority shall pay to  
6 the city of Boston, a proportionate share of such assessment or

7 assessments computed by multiplying such total assessment or  
 8 assessments to the city of Boston by a fraction the numerator  
 9 of which is the total assessed valuation of all tax exempt  
 10 property, real and personal, of the Massachusetts Port  
 11 Authority in the city of Boston, and the denominator of which  
 12 is the total assessed valuation of all property, real and personal,  
 13 in the city of Boston.

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the  
 contrary, including generally section 1 of chapter 45A of the  
 acts of 1956, in any year in which the city of Boston for the  
 year of 1972, the Massachusetts Port Authority is liable  
 and directed to reimburse the city of Boston for a  
 proportionate share of the city of Boston's annual assessments  
 for the use and service provided by the Massachusetts Port  
 Authority in any year in which such assessments  
 or payments shall be made upon the city of Boston in  
 accordance with sections 9, 10 and 11 of chapter 45A of the acts of  
 1956, or payment to any city pursuant to section 11

SECTION 2. Upon receipt by the city of Boston of the  
 statement of assessments for the use and service provided  
 by the Massachusetts Port Authority, the city of  
 Boston shall request payment by the Massachusetts Port  
 Authority, and the Massachusetts Port Authority shall pay to  
 the city of Boston a proportionate share of such assessments
