AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE ANNUAL RATE OF COMPENSATION OF CERTAIN HEADS OF FIRE DEPARTMENTS AND POLICE DEPARTMENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 48 of the General Laws as amended by chapter
2 1082 of the acts of 1971, is hereby amended by inserting after
3 the last sentence of section 57G, the following new sen-
4 tence: — This act shall not take effect until January 1, 1973.
