## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Two.

AN ACT TO INCREASE THE SALARIES OF ASSISTANT DISTRICT ATTORNEYS IN THE COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 That chapter 12 be amended by striking out section 16 and  
2 inserting in place thereof the following section: —

3 *Section 16.* Assistant district attorneys shall receive from the  
4 commonwealth salaries as follows:

5 For the Suffolk district, one assistant, sixteen thousand dol-  
6 lars; eight assistants fifteen thousand eight hundred dollars;  
7 four assistants thirteen thousand eight hundred dollars; two  
8 assistants, twelve thousand one hundred dollars; ten assistants  
9 eleven thousand dollars; and three assistants, ten thousand  
10 dollars.

11 For the eastern district, one assistant, eleven thousand five  
12 hundred dollars; one assistant, ten thousand five hundred dol-  
13 lars; and seven assistants, nine thousand five hundred dollars.

14 For the middle district, one assistant, eleven thousand five  
15 hundred dollars; five assistants, ten thousand five hundred dol-  
16 lars; six assistants, nine thousand five hundred dollars.

17 For the Norfolk district, one assistant, eleven thousand five  
18 hundred dollars; one assistant, ten thousand five hundred dol-  
19 lars; and seven assistants, nine thousand five hundred dollars.

20 For Plymouth district, one assistant, eleven thousand five

21 hundred dollars; one assistant, ten thousand five hundred dol-  
22 lars; and five assistants, nine thousand five hundred dollars.

23 For the southern district, one assistant eleven thousand five  
24 hundred dollars; one assistant, ten thousand five hundred dol-  
25 lars; and six assistants, nine thousand five hundred dollars.

26 For the western district, one assistant, eleven thousand five  
27 hundred dollars; two assistants, ten thousand five hundred dol-  
28 lars; two assistants, nine thousand five hundred dollars.

29 For the northwestern district, five assistants, eight thousand  
30 dollars.

31 For the northern district, three assistants, fourteen thousand  
32 seven hundred dollars; ten assistants, eleven thousand four  
33 hundred dollars; and two assistants, eleven thousand dollars.
