**AN ACT INCREASING THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE BOARD OF STATE EXAMINERS OF PLUMBERS.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 36 of chapter 13, as most recently amended by  
2 chapter 191 of the acts of 1963, is hereby further amended by  
3 striking out in the first paragraph the first sentence and insert-  
4 ing in place thereof the following new sentence: —

5 There shall be a board of state examiners of plumbers, in  
6 sections thirty-seven and thirty-eight called the examiners, con-  
7 sisting of five members, citizens of the commonwealth, of  
8 whom one shall have had at least ten years' continuous prac-  
9 tical experience as a master plumber, one shall be a sanitary  
10 engineer, one a journeyman plumber of at least ten years'  
11 practical experience, who is a wage earner, one a representative  
12 of industry and one a member of the general public.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as  
follows:

- 3 striking out in the first paragraph the first sentence and words
- 4 "as in place thereof the following new sentence":
