AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE ASSESSMENT OF COLLECTION COSTS AND/OR ATTORNEYS' FEES IN CONSUMER CREDIT CONTRACTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 10 of chapter 255D of the General Laws is hereby
- 2 amended by adding after subsection C a new subsection: —
- 3 *D.* An installment seller may in a retail installment sale
- 4 agreement contract for, and if so contracted for, assess the
- 5 costs of collection including reasonable attorneys' fees.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE SALE OF LANDS BELONGING TO THE STATE OF KENTUCKY
AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

It is enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the State of Kentucky in General Assembly met and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. Section 10 of chapter 220 of the General Laws of Kentucky is amended by striking after subsection 2 a new subsection 3.
2. An additional section may be added to the said chapter 220 of the General Laws of Kentucky, and it is enacted that the same be as follows:
3. The words "and it is enacted that the same be as follows" shall be inserted at the end of the said section 10.
