AN ACT TO PROVIDE TUITION FREE COURSES BE MADE AVAILABLE TO THE HANDICAPPED.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Any course of study available in State primary, secondary,
- 2 or schools of higher learning, regional vocational and any other
- 3 special programs, including community colleges and colleges,
- 4 shall be made available to paraplegics and those persons con-
- 5 fined to a wheelchair on a tuition free basis.
