AN ACT REGULATING THE SHOWING OF CERTAIN MOTION PICTURES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 6 of the General Laws is hereby amended by insert-
2 ing after section 101 the following section: —

3 *Section 101A.* The members of the commission appointed
4 under the provisions of section one hundred and one shall
5 preview all GP and G rated motion pictures before they are
6 exhibited, and if the majority of the board disagrees with the
7 rating so established it shall make this known to the distributor
8 of the picture and whenever this picture is advertised for
9 showing in addition to the rating established by the motion
10 picture industry the add shall also show the rating determined
11 by such commission.
