## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

### AN ACT REQUIRING RETIREMENT BOARDS TO INCLUDE NON-SALARIED SERVICE BY SCHOOL COMMITTEE MEMBERS IN COMPUTING RETIREMENT BENEFITS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Subdivision (1) of section 4 of chapter 32 of the General  
2 Laws is hereby amended by striking out paragraph (o) and  
3 inserting in place thereof the following paragraph: —  
4 (o) Any member who served as a selectman, alderman, city  
5 councillor or member of the school committee as the result of  
6 direct vote of the people in which position he received no  
7 compensation, may establish credit for such service by depos-  
8 iting in the annuity savings fund of the system of which he is a  
9 member a sum equal to the amount which would have been  
10 paid into such fund during such period if such position had  
11 been compensated at the rate of twenty-five hundred dollars  
12 per year, plus regular interest to the date of payment.
