RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION OF THE ADVISABILITY OF CHANGING THE LAWS OF THE COMMONWEALTH RELATIVE TO ABORTION.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of two
2 members of the senate, three members of the house of repre-
3 sentatives and two persons to be appointed by the governor, is
4 hereby established for the purpose of making an investigation
5 and study of the advisability of changing the laws of the
6 commonwealth relative to abortion.
