By Mr. Hurrell of North Andover, petition of James P. Hurrell that certain county employees be placed under the civil service law and rules. Counties.

AN ACT PLACING CERTAIN COUNTY EMPLOYEES UNDER THE CIVIL SERVICE LAW AND RULES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The first paragraph of section 3 of chapter 31
2 of the General Laws, as appearing in chapter 702 of the acts of
3 1945, is hereby amended by striking out the first sentence and
4 inserting in place thereof the following sentence: — Subject to
5 the approval of the governor and council, the commission from
6 time to time shall make and may amend rules which shall
7 regulate the selection and employment of persons to fill
8 positions in the official service and labor service of the com-
9 monwealth, of the counties and of the cities and towns
10 thereof, which positions are subject to any provision of this
11 chapter.

1 SECTION 2. The second paragraph of said section 3 of said
2 chapter 31, as so appearing, is hereby amended by inserting
3 after the word "court", in line 7, the words: — , the county
4 commissioners.

1 SECTION 3. Section 4 of chapter 31, as most recently
2 amended by section 1 of chapter 652 of the acts of 1956, is
3 hereby further amended by adding at the end the following
4 paragraph: —

5 The labor service and clerical service in counties and all
6 offices and positions in county correctional institutions.
