AN ACT EXTENDING THE FIFTY PERCENT STATE FINANCIAL AID PROVISION TO CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS OF SCHOOL BUILDINGS WHICH RECEIVED BOARD OF EDUCATION APPROVAL PRIOR TO JANUARY FIRST, NINETEEN HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-ONE, BUT WHICH HAVE NOT YET BEEN OCCUPIED.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 1010 of the acts of 1971 is hereby amended by
2 striking out section 6 and inserting in place thereof the follow-
3 ing section: —
4 *Section 6.* This act shall apply only to projects approved by
5 the board of education on or after January one, nineteen hun-
6 dred and seventy-one, and to projects which are under con-
7 struction but unoccupied on said date, and to projects so
8 approved but unoccupied on said date, and to projects so
9 approved but construction of which has not commenced prior
10 to said date.
