## **The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Two.

AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT TWO THIRDS OF THE DELEGATES TO THE RESPECTIVE NATIONAL CONVENTIONS SHALL BE CHOSEN FROM THE CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICTS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 70B of chapter 53 of the General Laws, as amended  
2 by the acts of 1966, is hereby further amended by adding the  
3 following sentence after the second sentence thereof: — Not  
4 less than two thirds of all delegates and alternate delegates shall  
5 be chosen from the congressional districts. The words, “Not  
6 less than two from each congressional district” which appear in  
7 the second sentence shall be deleted.
