RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO THE DIFFERENTIAL IN SALARIES PAID BY THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT TO CERTAIN STATE EMPLOYEES IN THIS COMMONWEALTH AS COMPARED TO SALARIES PAID TO EMPLOYEES IN SIMILAR POSITIONS IN OTHER STATES AND IN FEDERAL SERVICE AND ANY OTHER RELATED MATTERS.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of two
2 members of the senate, three members of the house of repre-
3 sentatives and two persons to be appointed by the governor, is
4 hereby established for the purpose of making an investigation
5 and study relative to the differential in salaries paid by the
6 federal government to certain state employees in this common-
7 wealth as compared to salaries paid to employees in similar
8 positions in other states and federal service and any other
9 related matters.
