## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE CHANGE OF THE TITLE OF THE MESSENGER OF THE JUSTICES OF THE SUPREME JUDICIAL COURT TO THE TITLE OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE ASSISTANT TO THE JUSTICES OF THE SUPREME JUDICIAL COURT.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 76 of chapter 221 of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by striking out the first two sentences of said section  
3 and inserting in place thereof the following: —  
4 In addition to the amount of salary payable by Suffolk  
5 county, fixed under the provisions of sections forty-nine to  
6 fifty-six, inclusive, of chapter thirty-five, to the administrative  
7 assistant to the justices of the supreme judicial court in said  
8 county, there shall annually be paid by the commonwealth to  
9 such administrative assistant such sum as shall be determined  
10 by the justices of said court. The administrative assistant to the  
11 justices of the supreme judicial court in Suffolk county shall be  
12 appointed by the justices of said court and shall also act as  
13 clerical assistant of said justices.
