AN ACT ESTABLISHING AN ADMINISTRATIVE COMMITTEE OF THE CLERKS OF THE DISTRICT COURTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 218 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting after section 43D the following section: —
- 3 *Section 43E.* There shall be an administrative committee of
- 4 the clerks of the district courts, other than the municipal court
- 5 of the city of Boston, which shall consist of seven clerks of
- 6 such district courts, appointed by the governor, each for a
- 7 period not exceeding two years as the governor may determine.
- 8 Any such clerk may be reappointed. Said administrative com-
- 9 mittee shall elect a chairman from among its members and shall
- 10 serve as an advisory committee to the chief justice of the
- 11 district courts and shall perform such duties as he may assign
- 12 to it. The members of the administrative committee shall, upon
- 13 certification of the chief justice of the district courts, be
- 14 allowed their traveling and other necessary expenses incurred in
- 15 the performance of their duties, subject to the approval of the
- 16 governor and council, to be paid from the state treasury.
