By Mr. McGee of Lynn, petition of Thomas W. McGee for legislation to provide that an assistant clerk of the Third District Court of Eastern Middlesex be placed in charge of civil sessions. Counties.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT AN ASSISTANT CLERK OF THE THIRD DISTRICT COURT OF EASTERN MIDDLESEX BE PLACED IN CHARGE OF CIVIL SESSIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 10 of chapter 218 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by striking out the eighth paragraph, as most recently
3 amended by section 2 of chapter 765 of the acts of 1971, and
4 inserting in place thereof the following paragraph: —
5 A sixth, seventh and eighth assistant clerk with salaries
6 payable by the county may be appointed in the third district
7 court of eastern Middlesex, one of whom shall be in charge of
8 six-man jury sessions and whose salary shall be the same as that
9 of the first assistant clerk, and one of whom shall be desig-
10 nated by the clerk to be in charge of civil sessions and whose
11 salary shall be the same as that of the first assistant clerk.
