By Mr. Olver of Amherst, petition of John W. Olver and Alan D. Sisitsky that faculty members from each campus of the University of Massachusetts be elected to the board of trustees. Education.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Two.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR FACULTY MEMBERS FROM EACH CAMPUS TO BE ELECTED TO THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE UNIVERSITY OF MASSACHUSETTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 20 of chapter 15 of the General Laws,
2 as most recently amended by chapter 725 of the acts of 1971,
3 is hereby further amended by striking the first sentence and
4 inserting in place thereof the following sentence: —

5 There shall be a board of trustees of the University of
6 Massachusetts consisting of the governor, the commissioner of
7 education, the commissioner of agriculture, the commissioner
8 of public health, the commissioner of mental health, the chair-
9 man of the board of selectmen of the town of Amherst who
10 shall not have voting power, the president of the university, ex
11 officio, two elected representatives of the student body, one of
12 whom shall be from the Amherst campus, one of whom shall
13 be from the Boston campus, three elected faculty members,
14 one each from the Amherst, Boston and Worcester campuses
15 and not more than seventeen appointive members, none of
16 whom shall be affiliated in any capacity with a private medical
17 school.

1 SECTION 2. Said section 20 of said chapter 15 is hereby
2 further amended by adding at the end thereof the following: —

3 The three elected faculty members shall be chosen by each
4 campus based on procedures promulgated by the general
5 faculty of that campus. Elected faculty members shall serve
6 three-year terms provided that they retain their status as faculty
7 members of the campus of their employment.
