By Mr. Murphy of Brockton, petition of Paul Maurice Murphy and another relative to certain expenses incidental to adequate and reasonable medical and hospital services which an insurer shall furnish an injured employee. Insurance.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO CERTAIN EXPENSES INCIDENTAL TO ADEQUATE AND REASONABLE MEDICAL AND HOSPITAL SERVICES WHICH AN INSURER SHALL FURNISH AN INJURED EMPLOYEE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 30 of chapter 152 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by striking out the first sentence and inserting in
3 place thereof the following sentence: —

4 The insurer shall furnish to an injured employee adequate
5 and reasonable medical and hospital services, and medicines if
6 needed, together with the expenses necessarily incidental to
7 such services, and in the case of a severely injured employee,
8 shall be given a physical examination by a registered physician
9 at least once in every calendar year during which he is resident
10 in such institution.
