AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE QUALIFICATIONS FOR APPOINTMENT TO THE OFFICE OF CITY MANAGER IN PLAN E CITIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The first paragraph of section 103 of chapter 43 of the
2 General Laws is hereby amended by striking out the last
3 sentence, as most recently amended by chapter 353 of the acts
4 of 1950, and inserting in place thereof the following sen-
5 tence: — No member of the city council shall during his term
6 of office be chosen as city manager, and no person who has
7 within four years been elected to or served in any elective
8 office in the city or in the county in which the city is located
9 or in the commonwealth shall be chosen as city manager.
