AN ACT TO ALLOW TIME ACCRUED AS AN ELECTED MEMBER OF A LOCAL SCHOOL COMMITTEE TO BE COUNTED TOWARD A PUBLIC SERVICE PENSION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The time accrued as an elected member of a local school
- 2 committee may be counted towards a public service pension
- 3 provided the individual concerned contributes all of the back
- 4 money to the pension fund.
