2 members of the senate, three members of the house of repre-  
3 sentatives and two persons to be appointed by the governor, is  
4 hereby established for the purpose of making an investigation  
5 and study relative to providing a more equitable method of  
6 awarding ice time on the metropolitan district commission  
7 skating rinks.
