AN ACT FURTHER SPECIFYING THE SECURITY DEPOSITS ON WHICH LANDLORDS MUST PAY INTEREST.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 666 of the acts of 1970 is hereby amended by

- 6 deposits received before, on or after said date.
