AN ACT REQUIRING SCHOOL COMMITTEES TO PROVIDE THE SAME HEALTH SERVICES TO PUPILS IN PRIVATE SCHOOLS AS ARE PROVIDED TO PUPILS IN THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Chapter 71 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting after section 47A the following section: —
- 3 *Section 47B.* Every school committee shall provide the same
- 4 health services to pupils in private schools as it provides pupils
- 5 in the public schools.

THE COMMISSION OF EDUCATION, created by the act of the Michigan Legislature, approved March 2, 1903, and continued by subsequent acts, has the honor to submit herewith its report for the year 1903.
