1 *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of three
2 members of the senate, five members of the house of represen-
3 tatives, and five persons to be appointed by the governor, is
4 hereby established for the purpose of making an investigation
5 and study relative to reviewing the election laws of the com-
6 monwealth.

and the report shall be published in the State
