By Mr. Perrault of Westford, petition of Mark W. Mulligan and Felix R. Perrault for legislation to require that profits derived from the sale of vanity motor vehicle registration plates be used for air pollution control purposes. Public Safety.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Two.

AN ACT REQUIRING THAT ALL PROFIT DERIVED FROM THE SALE OF VANITY MOTOR VEHICLE REGISTRATION NUMBER PLATES BE USED FOR AIR POLLUTION CONTROL PURPOSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 33 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as amended
- 2 by chapter 453 of the acts of 1971, is hereby further amended
- 3 by inserting after the second paragraph the following: —
- 4 All money derived from the sale of vanity motor vehicle
- 5 registration number plates, above the cost of manufacturer and
- 6 administration, be directed to the bureau of air use manage-
- 7 ment for the enforcement of air pollution regulations.
