## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Two.

### AN ACT INCREASING THE SALARIES OF THE CLERKS AND ASSISTANT CLERKS OF THE SUPERIOR COURT.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 94 of chapter 221 of the General Laws  
2 is hereby amended by striking out the schedule, under the  
3 caption SUPERIOR COURT FOR CRIMINAL BUSINESS IN  
4 THE COUNTY OF SUFFOLK, as most recently amended by  
5 section 1 of chapter 888 of the acts of 1969, and inserting in  
6 place thereof the following schedule: —

7 *Clerk.* — Twenty-five thousand five hundred and sixty-four  
8 dollars.

9 *First Assistant Clerk (so designated by the clerk).* — A sum  
10 equivalent to eighty per cent of the salary of the clerk.

11 *Second Assistant Clerk (so designated by the clerk).* — A sum  
12 equivalent to seventy-five per cent of the salary of the clerk.

13 *All Other Assistant Clerks.* — A sum equivalent to sixty-five  
14 per cent of the salary of the clerk.

1 SECTION 2. Said section 94 of said chapter 221 is hereby  
2 further amended by striking out the schedule under the caption  
3 SUPERIOR COURT FOR CIVIL BUSINESS IN THE COUNTY  
4 OF SUFFOLK, as most recently amended by section 2 of said  
5 chapter 888, and inserting in place thereof the following  
6 schedule: —

7 Clerk. — Twenty-five thousand five hundred and sixty-four  
8 dollars.

9 First Assistant Clerk (so designated by the justices of said  
10 court). — A sum equivalent to eighty per cent of the salary of  
11 the clerk.

12 Assistant Clerk (appointed to perform the duties of clerk  
13 pertaining to equity proceedings in said court and designated to  
14 act as clerk of said court when sitting in Boston for the hearing  
15 of causes from any other county). — A sum equivalent to  
16 eighty per cent of the salary of the clerk, of which the sum of  
17 twenty-five hundred dollars shall be paid by the common-  
18 wealth.

19 All Other Assistant Clerks. — A sum equivalent to sixty-five  
20 per cent of the salary of the clerk.

21 In all other counties, the salaries of the clerks of the courts  
22 shall be as follows: —

23 Middlesex — Twenty-five thousand five hundred and sixty-  
24 four dollars.

25 Essex — Twenty-three thousand eight hundred and seventy-  
26 two dollars.

27 Worcester — Twenty-three thousand eight hundred and  
28 seventy-two dollars.

29 Norfolk — Twenty-three thousand eight hundred and seventy-  
30 two dollars.

31 Hampden — Twenty-two thousand one hundred and seventy-  
32 one dollars.

33 Bristol — Twenty-two thousand one hundred and seventy-one  
34 dollars.

35 Plymouth — Twenty-one thousand seven hundred and eighty  
36 dollars.

37 Berkshire — Nineteen thousand two hundred and fifty dol-  
38 lars.

39 Hampshire — Seventeen thousand and fifty dollars.

40 Barnstable — Seventeen thousand and fifty dollars.

41 Franklin — Seventeen thousand and fifty dollars.

42 Dukes — Eight thousand two hundred and fifty dollars.

43 Nantucket — Eight thousand two hundred and fifty dollars.

44 In all counties other than Suffolk the assistant clerk shall  
45 receive a sum equivalent to eighty per cent of the salary of the

46 clerk, the second assistant clerk shall receive a sum equivalent  
47 to seventy-five per cent of the salary of the clerk and all other  
48 assistant clerks shall receive a sum equivalent to sixty-five per  
49 cent of the salary of the clerk.

1 SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any provision of this act to  
2 the contrary, the provisions of section 94 of chapter 221 of  
3 the General Laws in effect immediately prior to the effective  
4 date of this act shall remain in effect and apply to the salaries  
5 of persons appointed to the offices referred to therein between  
6 the effective date of this act and January 3, 1973.
