Ronayne, Jr., and another that the county commissioners of Norfolk County be authorized to expend a certain sum of money for the purpose of promoting the recreational, vacation and convention, commercial and industrial resources of said county. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF NORFOLK COUNTY TO EXPEND A CERTAIN SUM OF MONEY FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROMOTING THE RECREATIONAL, VACATION AND CONVENTION, COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL RESOURCES OF SAID COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 53 of the acts of 1963 is hereby
2 repealed.

1 SECTION 2. The county commissioners of Norfolk county
2 may, for the purpose of promoting the recreational, vacation
3 and convention, commercial and industrial resources of said
4 county, expend such sums, not exceeding fifty thousand dollars
5 in any one year, as may be appropriated therefor; provided,
6 that such expenditures from money so appropriated shall not
7 at any time be more than three times the sum which shall have
8 been contributed by public subscription or by donation de-
9 posited with the county treasurer for the purpose aforesaid.
10 Said commissioners may expend such sums for advertising in
11 newspapers, magazines and the like for booklets, posters and
12 facilities guides, for all forms of advertising, for information
13 booths and the staffing thereof within the county, for displays

14 or booths and the staffing thereof maintained at fairs, ex-
15 positions or travel shows outside the county, for such other promo-
16 tional activities as may be reasonably necessary to effectuate
17 the purposes of this act and the processing of inquiries re-
18 sulting from such promotional activities. In carrying out the
19 provisions of this act the commissioners may designate an agent
20 or agents to act for them; provided, that all bills incurred shall
21 be accompanied by proper vouchers and shall be paid by the
22 county treasurer only on warrants approved by the county
23 commissioners or a majority of them.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its acceptance
2 during the current year by the county commissioners of Nor-
3 folk county, but not otherwise.
