## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Two.

**AN ACT PROVIDING THAT ELIGIBILITY FOR CIVIL SERVICE POSITIONS BE BASED ONLY ON ONE LIST FOR ANY ONE POSITION.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 12 of chapter 31 of the General Laws  
2 is hereby amended by striking out the last sentence of the first  
3 paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following sen-  
4 tences: — Not more than one eligible list shall be established or  
5 maintained for any one position. Eligibility of applicants for  
6 placement on, and their standing on the eligible list shall be  
7 determined on the basis of the last examination taken for such  
8 position.

1 SECTION 2. The provisions of this act shall not apply to  
2 any civil service list in existence at the time this act becomes  
3 effective.
