By Mr. Hogan of Everett, petition of William F. Hogan relative to the retirement of certain teachers with thirty-five years or more of creditable service. Public Service.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Two.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE RETIREMENT OF CERTAIN TEACHERS WITH THIRTY-FIVE YEARS OR MORE OF CREDITABLE SERVICE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 32 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting after section 28B the following section: —
- 3 *Section 28C.* Notwithstanding any provision of law to the
- 4 contrary, any person who is a member of the teachers retire-
- 5 ment system with thirty-five years or more of creditable service
- 6 and who is not less than sixty years of age, shall, at his own
- 7 request, be retired at eighty per cent of his highest annual rate
- 8 of compensation.
