AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE AUTHORITY OF THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION TO MAINTAIN RESERVATIONS, PLAYGROUNDS AND HIGHWAYS IN THE METROPOLITAN PARKS DISTRICT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. The metropolitan district commission is hereby
2 authorized and directed to take over the control and main-
3 tenance of, by transfer, deed, gift or, whenever necessary, by
4 eminent domain, the following described parcels of land and
5 highways in the following cities and towns and to maintain the
6 same reservations, playgrounds, highways or parkways: —
7 (1) That portion of Dedham Street located in the Hyde Park
8 District of the City of Boston extending from the end of the
9 existing paved surface to a point of intersection with River
10 Street in said city;
11 (2) That portion of American Legion Highway in the City
12 of Boston beginning at Blue Hill Avenue and extending to
13 Cummins Highway in the Roslindale district of said city;
14 (3) That portion of Beacon Street located partly in the City
15 of Newton and partly in the Brighton District of the City of
16 Boston beginning at the intersection of Chestnut Hill Avenue at
17 Cleveland Circle in said city and extending to Hammond Pond
18 Parkway in the City of Newton;

19 (4) A certain parcel of land located in the City of Quincy
20 known as Squaw Rock.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
