**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Two.

RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO THE ADVISABILITY OF ESTABLISHING A SULLIVAN SQUARE DEVELOPMENT AND HISTORICAL PRESERVATION COMMISSION.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consists of three  
2 members of the senate, seven members of the house of rep-  
3 resentatives, and five persons to be appointed by the governor,  
4 is hereby established for the purpose of making an investigation  
5 and study relative to the advisability of establishing a Sullivan  
6 Square Development and Historical Preservation Commission.

The Representative House of Deputies and Court of Deputies  
of the Republic of Cuba, in the month of August 1901, in the  
exercise of its powers, has decreed the following:  
Article 1. The Government of Cuba is authorized to create a  
special commission for the purpose of studying the  
question of the organization of the judicial power.  
Article 2. The special commission shall be composed of  
three members, one of whom shall be designated by the  
Government, and the other two by the House of Deputies.  
Article 3. The special commission shall report to the  
House of Deputies within the term of three months.  
Article 4. The special commission shall have the right  
to call upon the Government for the documents and  
information necessary for the fulfillment of its duties.  
Article 5. The special commission shall be organized  
within the term of one month from the date of its  
creation.
