## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Two.

### AN ACT PLACING THE CONSTRUCTION OF ALL COUNTY BUILDINGS UNDER THE CONTROL OF THE BUREAU OF BUILDING CONSTRUCTION.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 14 of chapter 34 of the General Laws,  
2 as most recently amended by chapter 58 of the acts of 1947, is  
3 hereby further amended by striking out the first sentence.

1 SECTION 2. The first sentence of section 22 of chapter 6A  
2 of the General Laws, as appearing in section 3 of chapter 704  
3 of the acts of 1969, is hereby amended by inserting after the  
4 word "commonwealth", in line 6, the words: - or by any  
5 county.

1 SECTION 3. The second paragraph of said section 22 of  
2 said chapter 6A, as so appearing, is hereby further amended by  
3 inserting after the word "commonwealth", in line 14, the  
4 words: - or any county.

1 SECTION 4. Section 27 of said chapter 6A, as so appearing,  
2 is hereby amended by striking out clause 4 and inserting in  
3 place thereof the following clause: - 4. From the county com-  
4 missioners or from each agency of the commonwealth which  
5 has or shall have charge of any building owned by or main-  
6 tained at the expense of the commonwealth, or any county, he

7 shall request, and the agency or the commissioner shall  
8 promptly furnish, periodic maintenance reports in such form  
9 and containing such information as he shall from time to time  
10 determine.

1 SECTION 5. Section 28 of said chapter 6A, as so appearing,  
2 is hereby amended by inserting after the word "state-owned",  
3 in line 6, the words: — or county-owned.
