AN ACT REMOVING THE RESTRICTION ON ADOPTION SUBSIDIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 3 of chapter 963 of the acts of 1971 is hereby
2 amended by adding at the end thereof the following para-
3 graph: —

4 Upon approval by the governor, commissioner of public
5 welfare and the governor's special commission studying the care
6 of foster children, the one hundred adoption restriction when
7 reached may be removed.
