Chap. 6 An Act authorizing the town of rockport to invest in federal government bonds the unexpended balance of a certain loan issued by said town.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Section 1. The town of Rockport, under and subject to section one of chapter five of the acts of nineteen hundred and forty-three, may invest in defense bonds, war bonds or other bonds issued by the federal government a sum not exceeding twenty-one thousand, nine hundred and seventy-eight dollars and seventy-seven cents now in the town treasury, said sum being the unexpended balance of a loan issued by said town under authority of section one of chapter two hundred and eighty-seven of the acts of nineteen hundred and twenty-two, as amended by section one of chapter sixty-five of the acts of nineteen hundred and twenty-four.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

('hap. 7 An Act authorizing the town of andover to appropriate money in advance for the celebration of the tercentenary of the founding of the town.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Section 1. The town of Andover may appropriate money in the year nineteen hundred and forty-five for the celebration, in the year nineteen hundred and forty-six or in any later year to which said celebration may be postponed by said town, of the tercentenary of the founding of the town. Money so appropriated may be expended for said purpose in the years nineteen hundred and forty-five and nineteen hundred and forty-six, and in succeeding years up to and including the year in which said celebration occurs.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

Chap. 8 An Act to eliminate any special election of mayor in the city of boston prior to the next regular municipal election.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Section 1. There shall be no special election to fill any vacancy in the office of mayor of the city of Boston prior to the regular municipal election to be held in said city in the current year, notwithstanding the provisions of section forty-seven of chapter four hundred and eighty-six of the acts of nineteen hundred and nine, as most recently amended by section seven of chapter four hundred and seventy-nine of the acts of nineteen hundred and twenty-four.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
