AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE POWERS AND DUTIES OF THE COMMISSIONER OF THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 28 of the General Laws is hereby

2 amended by striking out section 3, as appearing in section 1 of

3 chapter 562 of the acts of 1961, and inserting in place thereof

4 the following section: -

Section 3. The commissioner shall devote his whole time 5

during business hours to the work of the commission and he

shall be the executive and administrative head of the com-

mission and shall organize it in such divisions as he may from

9 time to time determine. He may appoint a director of each

10 division to have charge of its work. Every such director shall be

11 subject to chapter thirty-one.

SECTION 2. Said chapter 28 is hereby further amended by 1 striking out section 4, as appearing in section 2 of said chapter 562, and inserting in place thereof the following section: -

Section 4. The commissioners may appoint a secretary, 4

engineering chiefs, engineers, inspectors, officers and members

of the police force, one or more women as special police

officers including school crossing guards, clerks and such other

officers and employees as the work of the commission may

require, may assign them to divisions, transfer and remove

them. The secretary shall be exempt from chapter thirty-one.
