AN ACT RELATIVE TO INFORMATION ON CONSUMER REPORTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 93 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting after section 47 the following section: —
- 3 *Section 47A.* Any adverse information on a consumer report
- 4 due to the unemployment of the consumer must be qualified
- 5 by stating that the consumer is presently unemployed.
