AN ACT TRANSFERRING THE TOWN OF WHITMAN FROM THE JUDICIAL DISTRICT OF THE SECOND DISTRICT COURT OF PLYMOUTH TO THE JUDICIAL DISTRICT OF THE DISTRICT COURT OF BROCKTON.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 218 of the General Laws  
2 is hereby amended by striking out the first paragraph under the  
3 caption "Plymouth" and inserting in place thereof the follow-  
4 ing paragraph: —

5 The second district court of Plymouth, held at Hingham,  
6 Abington, Hingham, Rockland, Hull, Hanover, Scituate,  
7 Norwell and Hanson.

1 SECTION 2. The fourth paragraph of said section 1 of said  
2 chapter 218 is hereby further amended by inserting after the  
3 word "Halifax" the word: — Whitman.

ACT TO WITHDRAW THE LANDS OF WITHIN FROM THE PUBLIC DOMAIN FOR THE PURPOSE OF ESTABLISHING A NATIONAL MONUMENT ON THE FOREST LAND IN MONTANA.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That the Secretary of the Interior be and he is authorized to
