AN ACT REQUIRING ADMINISTRATORS OF PUBLIC AND PRIVATE MEDICAL INSTITUTIONS AND NURSING HOMES TO KEEP ITEMIZED ACCOUNTS OF MONEY EXPENDED BY THEM IN BEHALF OF THEIR PATIENTS FOR PERSONAL NEEDS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Administrators of all public and private medical
2 institutions and nursing homes shall be required to keep a
3 separate monthly itemized account of all money expended by
4 them in behalf of their patients for personal needs.

1 SECTION 2. Said accounts in section one shall be made
2 available to social case workers when the expenditures involve
3 public welfare monies.
