AN ACT RELATIVE TO FIXING THE FEES CHARGED BY THE SEVERAL BOARDS OF REGISTRATION IN THE COMMONWEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 112 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
2 inserting after section 1 the following section: —

3 *Section 1A.* Notwithstanding any provisions of this chapter
4 to the contrary, the director of registration shall confer with
5 the several boards of registration and, with their cooperation,
6 he shall fix the fees of all applicants for registration in such
7 amounts that the receipts therefrom shall be sufficient to take
8 care of the expenses of each respective board.
