AN ACT PROVIDING A MINIMUM RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE FOR PUBLIC EMPLOYEES WHO HAVE COMPLETED THIRTY YEARS OF CREDITABLE SERVICE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Subdivision (2) of section 5 of chapter 32 of the General
2 Laws, as most recently amended by chapter 889 of the acts of
3 1967, is hereby further amended by adding at the end thereof
4 the following subparagraph: —

5 (e) In any case where a member has completed at least
6 thirty years of creditable service and has attained age fifty-five,
7 the allowance paid under this section shall not be less than
8 fifty percent of the annual rate of compensation paid over the
9 last twelve months of his creditable service.
