AN ACT FURTHER DEFINING THE POWERS AND DUTIES OF THE COMMISSIONER OF THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 28 section 3 is hereby repealed and a new section
2 inserted: —

3 *Section 3.* The Commissioner shall devote his whole time
4 during business hours to the work of the Commission and he
5 shall be the executive and administrative head of the Commis-
6 sion and shall organize it in such divisions as he may from time
7 to time determine. He may appoint a director of each division
8 to have charge of its work. Every such director shall be subject
9 to Chapter 31.

10 Chapter 28 section 4 is hereby repealed and a new section
11 inserted: —

12 *Section 4.* The Commissioners may appoint a secretary,
13 engineering chiefs, engineers, inspectors, officers and members
14 of the police force, one or more women as special police
15 officers including school crossing guards, clerks and such other
16 officers and employees as the work of the commission may
17 require, may assign them to divisions, transfer and remove
18 them. The Secretary shall be exempt from Chapter 31.
