RESOLUTIONS MEMORIALIZING THE CONGRESS OF THE UNITED STATES TO ENACT LEGISLATION REMOVING DISCRIMINATION AGAINST A PERSON ON ACCOUNT OF SEX.

- 1 *Whereas*, The policy of the United States is to provide
- 2 liberty, justice and equal rights for all its citizens; and
- 3 *Whereas*, It appears that many citizens are denied equal
- 4 rights and opportunities on account of sex; therefore be it
- 5 *Resolved*, That the Massachusetts House of Representatives
- 6 hereby respectfully urges the Congress of the United States to
- 7 enact legislation of an equal rights amendment which would
- 8 provide that equality of rights under the law shall not be
- 9 denied or abridged by the United States or by any State on
- 10 account of sex; and be it further
- 11 *Resolved*, That a copy of these resolutions be transmitted
- 12 forthwith by the Secretary of the Commonwealth to the Presi-
- 13 dent of the United States, to the presiding officers of each
- 14 branch of Congress, and to each member of Congress from the
- 15 Commonwealth.
