1 *Whereas*, Attorney Peter V. Maggio of Everett is being
2 honored by his friends and civic leaders on Thursday, Febru-
3 ary 3, 1972 at Caruso's Diplomat in Saugus; and

4 *Whereas*, Attorney Maggio graduated from Boston College
5 with a Bachelor of Science Degree in Business Administration
6 in 1952 and from Boston College Law School with a Doctor of
7 Jurisprudence Degree in 1957, and while in college he was
8 Captain of the Hockey Team which became the Eastern
9 Champions, and he is a Past President of the New England
10 Amateur Hockey Association; and

11 *Whereas*, During World War II he was a paratrooper with the
12 famed 11th Airborne Division and he was hospitalized for many
13 months as a result of a broken back suffered in the line of
14 duty; and

15 *Whereas*, In addition to the exacting duties of his successful
16 law practice, he has been active in the civic and educational
17 affairs of Everett, serving two terms as School Committeeman
18 at Large, the last term as Chairman; now, therefore, be it

21 and expresses its best wishes to him; and be it further
