**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Two.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF MALDEN TO GRANT RETROACTIVE PAY RAISES TO CERTAIN CUSTODIANS OF THE SCHOOL DEPARTMENT OF SAID CITY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding the provision of any law to the contrary,  
2 the city of Malden is hereby authorized to grant a pay raise to  
3 certain custodians of the school department of said city as set  
4 forth in an agreement entered into between the city and said  
5 custodians in the year nineteen hundred and seventy, which  
6 raise may be retroactive for the period September first, nine-  
7 teen hundred and seventy through December thirty-first, nine-  
8 teen hundred and seventy.
