

By Mr. Conway of Malden, petition of James S. Conway (with the approval of the mayor and city council) that the city of Malden be authorized to borrow a certain sum of money for the further development of Forestdale Cemetery in said city. Local Affairs. [Local Approval Received.]

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Two.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF MALDEN TO BORROW A CERTAIN SUM OF MONEY FOR THE FURTHER DEVELOPMENT OF FORESTDALE CEMETERY IN SAID CITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The city of Malden may borrow from time to
2 time a sum not exceeding two hundred and fifty thousand
3 dollars for further developing land in the Forestdale cemetery
4 for burial purposes and for the construction of paths and
5 avenues and embellishing the grounds in said developed area,
6 and may issue bonds or notes therefor which shall bear on
7 their face the words, City of Malden, Forestdale Cemetery
8 Loan, Act of 1972. Said loan shall be payable in not more
9 than five years from its date. The proceeds from the sale of the
10 exclusive rights of burials and erecting tombs and cenotaphs
11 upon any of the lots of Forestdale cemetery, and of orna-
12 menting the same, shall be paid into the city treasury and shall
13 be kept separate from other funds and be appropriated to
14 reimburse the city for its payment of installments on the
15 aforementioned loan.

16 Indebtedness incurred under this act shall be within the
17 statutory limit, but shall, except as herein provided, be subject
18 to chapter forty-four of the General Laws, exclusive of the

19 limitation contained in the first paragraph of section seven
20 thereof.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
