AN ACT RELATIVE TO ESTABLISHING THE REPRESENTATIVE AND SENATORIAL DISTRICTS IN THE CITY OF CHICOPEE COMMENCING IN THE YEAR NINETEEN HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-FIVE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any provision of section one and four of
2 chapter fifty-four of the General Laws to the contrary, the ward
3 and precinct lines in the City of Chicopee, as enacted by the
4 Board of Aldermen at their meeting of December 30, 1971 shall
5 be used for the purpose of reporting the nineteen hundred and
6 seventy-one census to be used for determining the representative
7 and senatorial districts for the ten year period beginning January
8 first, nineteen hundred and seventy-five as provided in the
9 ninety-second amendment to the Constitution of the Common-
10 wealth.
