The committees on Rules of the two branches, acting concurrently, to whom was referred the Order (filed by Mr. McGee of Lynn) relative to reviving and continuing the joint special committee established (under House order No. 4698 of 1967 and most recently continued by Senate order No. 1290 of 1971) to make an investigation and study of the potentials of electronic data processing and computing machines in performing certain functions of legislative agencies, and the feasibility of using such machines for performing certain functions of the Legislature and legislative staffs (House, No. 5046), report that the same ought to be adopted.
